RESOLUTION NO. 218 -2016, APPROVING A TEMPORARY INCREASE IN FLEET FOR THE NEWLY FORMED LONG ISLAND HEROIN TASK FORCE UNIT AT NO COST TO THE COUNTY THROUGH THE USE OF ASSET FORFEITURE FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Suffolk County and Nassau County Police Departments have entered into a two-year agreement to create a cooperative Heroin Task Force Unit with their respective police departments; and

WHEREAS, this task force will be based out of Nassau County and consist of one Suffolk County Police Department Detective Sergeant and four Suffolk County Police Department Detectives along with Nassau County Police personnel; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the task force is to combat the heroin epidemic in both Nassau and Suffolk Counties; and

WHEREAS, the Police Commissioner finds that five undercover vehicles is paramount to the success of the Heroin Task Force Unit; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the Police Department is given authorization to temporarily increase the Suffolk County Police fleet by five vehicles (undercover vehicle to be determined), which lease will be funded through the use of Asset Forfeiture funds.
