**RESOLUTION NO. 552 -2016, TO APPOINT MEMBER OF  
SUFFOLK COUNTY YOUTH BOARD COORDINATING  
COUNCIL REPRESENTING LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT NO. 6  
(JOHN B. MACKAY)**

**WHEREAS**, Section A3-5(E)(1) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE provides for the appointment of members of the Suffolk County Youth Board Coordinating Council, including eighteen members representing each of the County's Legislative Districts; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 612-2014 appointed Janene Gentile, Executive Director of the North Shore Youth Council as a member of the Suffolk County Youth Board Coordinating Council for a term of three years set to expire on August 8, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, Janene Gentile vacated her position from the Suffolk County Youth Board Coordinating Council on May 11, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, Legislator Anker has recommended that John B .MacKay of the North Shore Youth Council, to fill this vacancy for the remainder of the unexpired term; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that, John B. MacKay currently residing in Rocky Point, NY is hereby appointed as a member of the Suffolk County Youth Board Coordinating Council to represent the 6th Legislative District on the Suffolk County Youth Board Coordinating Council for the remainder of the unexpired term of Janene Gentile set to expire on August 8,2017; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and/or (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
