

**RESOLUTION NO. 402 -2016, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH IMPROVEMENTS TO THE RIVERHEAD COUNTY CENTER SEWERS, PUMP STATION AND FORCE MAIN (CP 8142)**

**WHEREAS**, the Administrative Head of Sewer Districts has requested that funds be appropriated to cover construction costs associated with the Improvements to the Riverhead County Center Pump Station and Force Main; and

**WHEREAS**, there are sufficient funds in the 2016 Capital Budget and Program for the improvement of the Riverhead County Center sewers, pump station and force main; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006, established the use of a priority ranking system, implemented in the Adopted 2016 Capital Budget, as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to State Environmental Quality Review Act Environmental Conservation Law Article 8 (hereinafter "SEQRA") Resolution No. 106-2016 determined that the proposed improvement and/or rehabilitation to the Riverhead County Center sewers, pump station and force main constitutes a Type II action pursuant to the provisions of NYCRR Part 617.5; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$250,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of fifty-nine (59), is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the proceeds of \$250,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they hereby are appropriated as follows:

**3<sup>rd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Lead Agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II Action pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(C)(18), (20), (21), and (27) as the proposal involves the adoption of regulations, policies, procedures and local legislative decisions in connections with routine or continuing agency administration and management; and be it further

**4<sup>th</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the Administrative Head of the Sewer District be and he hereby is authorized, directed and empowered to enter into contracts and agreements upon such terms and conditions as he may deem necessary relating to the improvements to Riverhead County Center sewers, pump station and force main.
