**RESOLUTION NO. 454 -2016, APPROVING THE HIRING
OF A RELATIVE OF A COUNTY OFFICIAL IN THE
DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES (KELLY A. BERDOLT)**

WHEREAS, Section A6-3(B) of the Suffolk County Administrative Code requires legislative approval for the hiring or promotion of the spouse, issue, brother, sister, parent, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, parent-in-law, niece or nephew of a County Official for any position not being filled pursuant to New York Civil Service Law competitive examination; and

WHEREAS, Kelly A. Berdolt, wife of Deputy Commissioner of Public Works Philip Berdolt, was offered employment as a provisional Community Service Worker in the Department of Social Services; and

WHEREAS, Kelly Berdolt is qualified to fill this position; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that the hiring of Kelly A. Berdolt, wife of Deputy Commissioner of Public Works Philip Berdolt, as a provisional Community Service Worker in the Department of Social Services is hereby approved pursuant to Section A6-3(B) of the Suffolk County Administrative Code; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), N.Y. Environmental Conservation Law Article 8 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS ("NYCRR") in that the action constitutes routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment. The Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
