**RESOLUTION NO. 606 -2016, AUTHORIZING A LICENSE
AGREEMENT WITH THE HAUPPAUGE YOUTH
ORGANIZATION**

WHEREAS, the Hauppauge Youth Organization (HYO) is an Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) private, non-profit organization that provides athletic programs for young people in the Hauppauge community; and

WHEREAS, HYO has for many years successfully operated youth athletic programs on vacant County property in the Town of Islip, such premises identified as Suffolk County Tax Map No. 0500-012.00-02.00-042.000, under a license agreement with the County of Suffolk; and

WHEREAS, HYO has made substantial improvements that have enhanced the value of that County property as a recreational facility; and

WHEREAS, HYO's most recent license agreement with the County of Suffolk for the above described property has expired; and

WHEREAS, HYO and the County of Suffolk wish to enter into a new license agreement so that HYO may continue to maintain athletic fields and offer youth programs at the site; and

WHEREAS, the Space Management Steering Committee recommended the approval of terms on February 19, 2015; now, therefore be it

1ST RESOLVED, that the Suffolk County Department of Public Works is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed pursuant to Section C8-2 of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER, to enter into a license agreement for no monetary consideration with HYO for the purpose of providing athletic/recreation programs at the above described premises, for a term of five (5) years with an option to renew for an additional five (5) years, and upon such other terms and conditions as may be approved by the Suffolk County Attorney; and be it further

2ND RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20) and (26) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
