

**RESOLUTION NO. 531 -2016, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 100% GRANT FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, UNDER THE CRIMES AGAINST REVENUE PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, New York State Division of Criminal Justice has awarded grant funds to the Suffolk County District Attorney's Office for the Crimes Against Revenue Program; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant provides funding for personnel, equipment, and undercover expenses for the investigation and prosecution of individuals who violate the law by refusing to pay tax and other revenue related obligations associated with illegal activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the goal of the program is to reclaim lost revenue and increase voluntary compliance with applicable laws; and

**WHEREAS**, the award period begins January 1, 2016 and runs through December 31, 2016; the amount awarded is \$1,697,801; and

**WHEREAS**, this program is a continuation of the 2015 Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2016 Adopted Operating Budget includes \$1,370,950 in salary expense under appropriation 1185, \$255,691 in fringe benefit grant expense and \$1,686,000 in revenue; and

**WHEREAS**, for the purposes of this resolution, it is requested that additional grant revenue in the amount of \$11,801 be accepted and the additional \$71,160 in expenses be appropriated in the 2016 Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate said grant funds as follows;
