**RESOLUTION NO. 566 -2016, TO APPOINT MEMBER OF  
THE SUFFOLK COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION (SAMUEL  
CHU)**

**WHEREAS**, Section 14-2(A) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER provides for the appointment of fifteen (15) members of the Suffolk County Planning Commission, one member from each of the ten (10) towns in Suffolk County, one member from an incorporated village of under 5,000 population, one member from an incorporated village of over 5,000 population, and three members from the County at large; and

**WHEREAS**, the term of office for Suffolk County Planning Commission member Ramon F. Accettella, Jr., representing the Town of Babylon, expired on December 31, 2014 (Resolution No. 698-2013); and Ramon F. Accettella, Jr., currently in hold over status, will vacate his position on or about July 1, 2016, as representative for the Town of Babylon; and

**WHEREAS**, Steven Bellone, the County Executive of Suffolk has appointed Samuel Chu, currently residing in Lindenhurst, NY 11757, as a member of the Suffolk County Planning Commission, representing the Town of Babylon, to fill the vacancy left by Ramon F. Accettella, Jr.; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that Samuel Chu, currently residing in Lindenhurst, NY, 11757 is hereby appointed as a member of the Suffolk County Planning Commission representing the Town of Babylon for the remainder of the vacated term, which will expire on December 31, 2018, pursuant to Section 14-2(A) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
