RESOLUTION NO. 532 -2016, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$153,970 IN STATE FUNDING FROM THE NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY SERVICES, FOR THE PUBLIC SAFETY ANSWERING POINT (PSAP) 2015 GRANT PROGRAM WITH 100% SUPPORT

WHEREAS, the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services, Office of Interoperable and Emergency Communications has made \$153,970 in State funding available to partially support the Suffolk County Police Department's project to enhance Suffolk County's Public Safety/E911 response through the implementation of Next Generation 911 Technologies; and

WHEREAS, said project is designed to improve the Suffolk County's capabilities with regard to response to and routing of Public Safety/E911 calls by consolidating multiple Public Safety Answering Points (PSAP) into a single system with each PSAP being a node on the system; and

WHEREAS, the operational period of the Project will be from January 1, 2016, through December 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, said grant funds totaling \$153,970 have not been included in the 2016 Suffolk County Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate said grant funds as follows:
