RESOLUTION NO. 530 -2016, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 100% STATE GRANT FUNDS FROM THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$16,576 FOR THE RABIES CONTROL PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES, DIVISION OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND TO EXECUTE GRANT RELATED AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Health has awarded Suffolk County State grant funds under the Rabies Control Program to be implemented by the Suffolk County Department of Health Services; and

WHEREAS, The Rabies Control Program grant funds will be used to rapidly identify and isolate a rabid animal and prevent further transmission to humans or other animals in Suffolk County; and

WHEREAS, this grant has a start date of 04/01/16 and ends on 03/31/17 in which the County will receive 100% grant funding in the amount of \$16,576 for the Rabies Control Program; and

WHEREAS, said funds have not been included in the 2016 Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, the County Comptroller be and hereby is authorized to accept \$16,576 and appropriate said grant funds as follows:
