**RESOLUTION NO. 685 -2016, AUTHORIZING EXECUTION
OF AN AGREEMENT BY THE ADMINISTRATIVE HEAD OF
SUFFOLK COUNTY SEWER DISTRICT NO. 20 - WILLIAM
FLOYD AND 64 RIDGE ROAD (BR-1665)**

WHEREAS, 64 Ridge Road in Ridge, New York is outside the boundary of Suffolk County Sewer District No. 20 – William Floyd; and

WHEREAS, the New York State Office for People with Developmental Disabilities (OPWDD) is the owner of the property located at 64 Ridge Road, Ridge, NY; and

WHEREAS, OPWDD has petitioned and requested the Administrative Head of the District for permission to discharge Four Thousand One Hundred Sixty-Five gallons per day (4,165 GPD); and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Administrative Head of the District that the District has wastewater treatment capacity Four Thousand One Hundred Sixty-Five gallons per day (4,165 GPD) in excess of its own needs; and

WHEREAS, the connection is subject to the approval of the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC); and

WHEREAS, the proposed flow has received the approval of the Suffolk County Sewer Agency (Resolution No. 1-2016) with a connection fee of One Hundred Twenty-Four Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$124,950), for the said Four Thousand One Hundred Sixty-Five gallons per day (4,165 GPD) of capacity; to the district; and

WHEREAS, it will be financially beneficial to Suffolk County Sewer District No. 20 – William Floyd and Suffolk County, as well as in the environmental interest of all of Suffolk County, for the connection to be made; now therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that pursuant to Section 617.5(c) (11) and (20), of the SEQRA regulations, this project is a Type II Action, and requires no further action; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that the Administrative Head of the District be and hereby is authorized, directed and empowered to enter into contracts and agreements with the NYS Office of People with Developmental Disabilities upon such terms and conditions as he may deem necessary relating to connections to the District of lands adjacent to Suffolk County Sewer District No. 20 – William Floyd and that they be required to post a surety bond or bonds and deposit cash or securities with the County Treasurer in those instances that the Administrative Head deems necessary to ensure performance of such agreements and contracts; and be it further

3rd **RESOLVED**, that the Suffolk County Department of Public Works is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to take such action as may be Necessary, pursuant to section C8-2(L&M) of the Suffolk County Charter.
