RESOLUTION NO. 623 -2016, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 100% FEDERAL PASS-THROUGH GRANT FUNDS FROM THE UNITED WAY OF LONG ISLAND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$87,108 FOR THE RYAN WHITE PART A MEDICAL CASE MANAGEMENT (“MCM”) ADMINISTERED BY THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES, DIVISION OF PATIENT CARE AND TO EXECUTE GRANT RELATED AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, the United Way of Long Island has awarded Suffolk County 100% federal pass-through funds under the Ryan White Part A Medical Case Management (“MCM”) program to be implemented by the Suffolk County Department of Health Services, Division of Patient Care; and

WHEREAS, the MCM will provide funds to the Department of Health Services to support health care and education of inmates to help reduce the spread of HIV/AIDS and to improve health outcomes for people living with HIV disease; and

WHEREAS, this grant has a start date of 3/1/2016 and ends on 2/28/2017 in which the County will receive 100% grant funding in the amount of \$87,108 for the Ryan White Part A Medical Case Management; and

WHEREAS, a portion of said funds have not been included in the 2016 Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, the MCM grant includes partial funding for the Department of Health Services to continue the employment of one (1) Public Health Nurse III (full-time); one (1) Medical Social Worker (full-time); and

WHEREAS, these positions already exist and are partially funded in the 2016 Operating Budget in 001-HSV-4101 as Position Numbers 3000-0007 (Public Health Nurse III); 4100-0100 (Medical Social Worker); now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, the County Comptroller be and they hereby are authorized to accept \$87,108 and appropriate said grant funds as follows:
