RESOLUTION NO. 626 -2016, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 28% NEW YORK STATE AND 72% FEDERAL PASS-THROUGH GRANT FUNDS FROM THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$171,662 FOR THE LEAD POISONING PREVENTION PROGRAM ("LPPP") ADMINISTERED BY THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES, DIVISION OF PATIENT CARE AND TO EXECUTE GRANT RELATED AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Health has awarded Suffolk County 28% New York State and 72% federal pass-through funds under the Lead Poisoning Prevention Program ("LPPP") to be implemented by the Suffolk County Department of Health Services, Division of Patient Care; and

WHEREAS, the LPPP will provide funds to the Department of Health Services to support screening for the early detection of childhood lead poisoning, particularly in high risk populations and to provide education to the public and private physicians; and

WHEREAS, this grant has a start date of 10/1/2015 and ends on 9/30/2016 in which the County will receive 100% grant funding in the amount of \$171,662 for the Lead Poisoning Prevention Program; and

WHEREAS, a portion of said funds have not been included in the 2016 Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, the LPPP grant includes partial funding for the Department of Health Services to continue the employment of one (1) Public Health Nurse IV (full-time); one (1) Medical Records Clerk (full-time); one (1) Clinical Nurse Practitioner (full-time); one (1) Associate Public Health Sanitarian (full-time); one (1) Senior Public Health Sanitarian (full-time); one (1) Public Health Sanitarian (full-time); and

WHEREAS, these positions already exist and are partially funded in the 2016 Operating Budget in 001-HSV-4101 as Position Numbers 3000-0004 (Public Health Nurse IV); 4100-6000 (Clinical Nurse Practitioner); 4100-0180 (Medical Records Clerk); and

WHEREAS, these positions already exist and are partially funded in the 2016 Operating Budget in 001-HSV-4015 as Position Numbers 2615-0026 (Associate Public Health Sanitarian); 2615-0045 (Senior Public Health Sanitarian); 2615-0060 (Public Health Sanitarian); now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, the County Comptroller be and hereby is authorized to accept \$171,662 and appropriate said grant funds as follows:
