**RESOLUTION NO. 643 - 2016, CONFIRMING APPOINTMENT
OF SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMISSIONER OF INFORMATION
TECHNOLOGY (SCOTT MASTELLON)**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 20-2(A) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER, the Commissioner of the Suffolk County Department of Information Technology is appointed by the County Executive of Suffolk County to head the Suffolk County Department of Information Technology, subject to the approval of the County Legislature; and

WHEREAS, Steven Bellone, the County Executive of Suffolk County, has appointed Scott Mastellon, currently residing in Smithtown, New York as Commissioner of the Suffolk County Department of Information Technology; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the appointment of Scott Mastellon, currently residing in Smithtown, New York as Commissioner of the Suffolk County Department of Information Technology is hereby approved, pursuant to Section 20-2(A) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER, to serve at the pleasure of the County Executive, effective immediately; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5 (c) (20) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 N.Y.C.R.R.) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109 (2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection. The Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this law.
