**RESOLUTION NO. 679 -2016, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH SUFFOLK COUNTY FIRE RESCUE MAIN BUILDING RENOVATIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS (CP 3418)**

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioner of Fire, Rescue and Emergency Services has requested funds for planning for the renovations and improvements to the Suffolk County Fire Rescue and Emergency Services Main Building; and

**WHEREAS**, there are sufficient funds within the 2016 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request under Capital Project No. 3418; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006, has established a priority ranking system of capital projects as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$250,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5 (C) (20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR"), in that the law authorizes information collection, including basic data collection and research, and preliminary planning processes necessary to formulate a proposal for an action, but does not commit the County to commence or approve an action, since this law is a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that it is determined that this program with a priority ranking of forty-nine (49) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

**3<sup>rd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the proceeds of \$250,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:
