**RESOLUTION NO. 627 -2016, AMENDING THE 2016  
 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO REALLOCATE 100%  
 STATE AID FROM HANDS ACROSS LONG ISLAND (HALI) TO  
 FAMILY RESIDENCES AND ESSENTIAL ENTERPRISES  
 (FREE) FOR HOUSING AND RESPITE SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, after a review of program performance and in discussion with the Suffolk County Division of Mental Hygiene, the New York State Office of Mental Health (NYS OMH) has directed the transfer of \$70,028 in 100% OMH State Aid funding from HALI to FREE; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds will support FREE's Single Point of Access (SPOA) housing program as well as their Crisis Respite Program effective January 1, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, these services support adults with serious mental illness in Suffolk County; and

**WHEREAS**, funding is currently included in the 2016 Adopted Operating Budget for HALI and needs to be reallocated to FREE; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller be and hereby is authorized to transfer \$70,028 in State Aid funding as follows:
