

RESOLUTION NO. 628 -2016, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$300,000 FROM THE NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR THE STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT TERRORISM PREVENTION PROGRAM (SLETPP) FFY2016 WITH 100% SUPPORT

WHEREAS, the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services has made \$300,000 in Federal pass-through funds from the 2016 State Homeland Security Grant program available to Suffolk County for the SLETPP FFY2016 Program to be administered by the Suffolk County Police Department; and

WHEREAS, this program is designed to assist law enforcement in the prevention, deterrence and response to terrorist attacks; and

WHEREAS, the operational period of the Program will be from September 1, 2016 through August 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, said grant funds have not been included in the 2016 Suffolk County Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate said grant funds as follows:
