

**RESOLUTION NO. 629 -2016, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT FROM THE NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PROBATION FOR THE PAROLE REENTRY TASK FORCE GRANT PROGRAM WITH 100% SUPPORT**

**WHEREAS**, the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services has awarded to Suffolk County \$90,960, to the Suffolk County Probation Department for continuation of the currently funded Reentry Task Forces operating in New York; and

**WHEREAS**, said funding will support the operation of the Suffolk County Reentry Task Force. The Suffolk County Reentry Task Force provides services to parolees recently released from state incarceration. The goals of the Suffolk County Reentry Task Force are: to reduce offender recidivism and increase public safety; to maintain a county-based service delivery system that addresses criminogenic and stabilization needs of moderate to high-risk persons and special populations released from prison; and to provide cognitive behavioral intervention (CBI) and/or employment readiness services; and

**WHEREAS**, \$49,071 of said grant funding for salary and fringes for two Program Coordinator positions has been included in the 2016 Operating Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, \$41,889.00 of the \$90,960.00 has not been included in the 2016 Operating Budget Expenditures to further this initiative; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant period for the award is July 1, 2016 through September 30, 2016; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that nothing contained herein shall be construed as obligating or committing the County of Suffolk to continue the employment of the individuals filling the positions created by this Resolution at the conclusion of the grant funding provided for such position created by said grant; and be it further

**2nd RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller be and hereby is authorized to accept and appropriate said grant funds as follows:
