RESOLUTION NO. 630 -2016, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR A 100% FEDERALLY FUNDED GRANT BEING PASSED THROUGH THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FOR THE DISPLACED HOMEMAKER PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Labor (NYSDOL) has awarded additional funds in the amount of \$16,919 to the Suffolk County Department of Labor, Licensing and Consumer Affairs to fund the Displaced Homemaker Program; and

WHEREAS, the allowable activities under this Grant include education and training; supportive services; counseling and employment related services; and

WHEREAS, this grant has a start date of August 1, 2015 and ends on August 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, these funds have not been included in the 2016 Adopted Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, these funds are 100% federally funded and being passed through the New York State Department of Labor; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller be and hereby is authorized to accept and appropriate the additional funds as follows:

4th **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20),(21) and (27) of the Title 6 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the New York Environmental Conservation Law as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council of Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
