**RESOLUTION NO. 683 -2016, APPOINTING LESLIE M. QUINN  
TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY CHILD FATALITY REVIEW TEAM**

**WHEREAS**, Local Law No. 9-2016, effective May 2, 2016, established the Child Fatality Review Team; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3 of the Local Law established that one of the members of the team will be a pediatrician or comparable medical professional with expertise in child abuse, maltreatment or pediatric forensics, to be appointed by the County Executive subject to legislative approval; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that, Leslie M. Quinn, a pediatrician who currently serves as the Division Chief of the Division of Child Advocacy in the Department of Pediatrics at SUNY Stony Brook, residing in East Setauket, New York, is hereby appointed as a member of the Suffolk County Child Fatality Review Team to serve for a term of two years; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), N.Y. Environmental Conservation Law Article 8 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS ("NYCRR") in that the action constitutes routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment. The Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
