

RESOLUTION NO. 844 -2016, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH THE RENOVATION OF KREILING HALL - AMMERMAN CAMPUS (CP 2114)

WHEREAS, the President of Suffolk County Community College and the Board of Trustees have requested funds for the implementation of the Master Plan Update – Phase II; and

WHEREAS, the New York State Legislature and the Governor have included funding in the New York State Budget to cover the State’s fifty percent share; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds have been included in the 2016 Capital Budget and Program to cover the County’s cost of the project; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006 established the use of a priority ranking system, implemented in the Adopted 2016 Capital Budget, as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

WHEREAS, that this Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$1,590,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of fifty-eight (58) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that the proceeds of \$1,590,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:

4th **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Lead Agency, hereby finds and determines that the adoption of this law is a Type II action, pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(C) (1), (2), (25) and (27), since it constitutes a local legislative decision in connection with the maintenance, repair, replacement, rehabilitation, reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site, including upgrading buildings to meet building or fire codes, purchase or sale of furnishings, equipment or supplies, including surplus government property, other than the following: land, radioactive material, pesticides, herbicides, or other hazardous materials; as a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA.
