

WHEREAS, homelessness continues to be a serious problem in Suffolk County and across our nation; and

WHEREAS, many of the homeless population are employed, however due to the recent economic recession and contributing rising costs of housing, fuel, food or other extreme circumstances which may have caused financial hardship, they are left to seek government assistance; and

WHEREAS, raising the public's awareness of the plight of the homeless, encouraging more citizens to become involved with a local host church, and raising additional funding to assist in the transportation of homeless individuals and families can be accomplished by designating "Homeless Awareness Month" in Suffolk County; and

WHEREAS, Suffolk County strives to raise awareness of the effects of homelessness on the population and economy; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the month of November is hereby declared "Homeless Awareness Month" in Suffolk County to raise awareness of the homeless crisis in Suffolk County; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.



WHEREAS, the 2009 Operating Budget does not include sufficient funds for Pederson Krag Post Adoption Services; and

WHEREAS, the Pederson Krag Post Adoption Services is a not-for-profit agency that provides valuable services to Suffolk County residents; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Suffolk County Legislature to amend the 2009 Operating Budget and transfer \$33,000 to the contracted agency Pederson Krag Post Adoption Services; and

WHEREAS, St. Vincent DePaul (Ryan House) has closed its doors and will not spend the funds provided in the 2009 Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, by independent analysis of the 2010 Recommended Operating Budget and the 2009 estimated budget by the Legislative Budget Review Office finds that there are excess appropriations in the 2009 estimated budget for St. Vincent DePaul (Ryan House); and

WHEREAS, the transfer of these funds will not impact the 2009 estimated General Fund year-ending surplus; and

WHEREAS, Section 4-31 (G) of the Suffolk County Charter now allows amendment of the County Operating Budget by County Legislators four times during the fiscal year as long as the amendment reduces, lowers, terminates or cancels appropriations; abolishes positions of employment; terminates contract agencies; terminates or reduces the size of County programs or departments, or makes transfers of appropriations that are offset by reductions in other programs; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the 2009 County Operating Budget is hereby amended as follows and that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to transfer the following funds and authorizations.


