WHEREAS, there was duly presented and introduced to this County Legislature at a regular meeting held on _____, 2010, a proposed local law entitled, "**A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE SUFFOLK COUNTY EMPIRE ZONE BOUNDARIES TO INCLUDE MITEQ, INC., SCTM NOS. 0800-182.00-01.00-033.022; 0800-182.00-01.00-033.023; 0800-182.00-01.00-033.029; 0800-182.00-01.00-033.041; 0800-182.00-01.00-033.042; 0800-182.00-01.00-033.049**"; and said local law in final form is the same as when presented and introduced; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that said local law be enacted in form as follows:

LOCAL LAW NO. -2010, SUFFOLK COUNTY, NEW YORK

**A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE SUFFOLK COUNTY EMPIRE

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF
SUFFOLK**, as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent.

This Legislature finds and determines that pursuant to Local Law No. 14-2003, this Legislature authorized the designation of an Empire Zone; that Local Law 40-2009 established Empire Zone boundaries; and that a new local law is required to submit to New York State a request to revise the zone boundaries to include Miteq, Inc., located at premises described as SCTM Nos. 0800-182.00-01.00-033.022; 0800-182.00-01.00-033.023; 0800-182.00-01.00-033.029; 0800-182.00-01.00-033.041; 0800-182.00-01.00-033.042; 0800-182.00-01.00-033.049.

This Legislature also finds and determines that New York State has amended the Empire Zone Program to include specific projects deemed as Regionally Significant Projects. Regionally Significant Projects are defined as site specific projects located outside the existing zone boundaries that will create fifty (50) or more jobs.

This Legislature further finds and determines that Miteq, Inc., a manufacturer of microwave based electronics, located at 110 Davids Drive and 320, 330 and 380 Oser Avenue, Hauppauge, New York, meets the criteria of Section 957(d) of the NEW YORK GENERAL

MUNICIPAL LAW for a Regionally Significant Project and has requested consideration for such designation by the Suffolk County Empire Zone - Zone Administrative Board.

Therefore, the purpose of this law is to authorize the submission of an application to New York State to amend the boundaries of the Suffolk County Empire Zone, to include the above location.

Section 2. Application.

The Suffolk County Empire Zone - Zone Administrative Board, is hereby authorized, empowered and directed in accordance with Section 3 of this Law to submit an application to the New York State Department of Economic Development to augment the boundaries of the existing Empire Zone and to execute such documents as are necessary and desirable to effectuate the purposes of this Law.

Section 3. Request for Consideration.

A.) The Commissioner of the New York State Department of Economic Development is hereby requested to revise the boundaries of the Empire Zone in accordance with this Law.

B.) The Clerk of the Suffolk County Legislature is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to file a certified copy of this local law with said Commissioner upon its adoption.

Section 4. Designation of Revised Empire Zone Boundaries.

The boundary of the Empire Zone, designated in Local Law 14-2003 and Local Law 40-2009, as adopted, shall be amended to include SCTM Nos. 0800-182.00-01.00-033.022; 0800-182.00-01.00-033.023; 0800-182.00-01.00-033.029; 0800-182.00-01.00-033.041; 0800-182.00-01.00-033.042; 0800-182.00-01.00-033.049.

Section 5. Real Property Tax Exemption.

A.) The property included in the revised boundaries as described and designated by this Law is hereby granted an exemption from the taxes and special ad valorem levies by the County of Suffolk and the exemption shall be granted for the period and to the extent provided for in Section 485-e of the New York Real Property Tax Law. This exemption shall be for a term of ten (10) years, notwithstanding that the designation of the Empire Zone may expire prior to the end of such ten (10) year term.

B.) The exemption granted pursuant to this Law shall only take effect as to the revised Empire Zone designation in the event that the revised designation is approved by New York State and placed on the tax rolls. In the event the revised Empire Zone designation is not approved, the exemption granted pursuant to Local Law No. 14-2003, as adopted, shall continue pursuant to the terms of that Law.

Section 6. Applicability.

This Law shall apply to all actions and taxable status dates occurring on or after the effective date except as otherwise provided for herein.

Section 7. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this law or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance, shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of the law, or in its application to the person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 8. SEQRA Determination.

This Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21), and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection. The Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination on non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this law.

Section 9. Effective Date.

This law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.



Enactment of this proposed local law would authorize the submission of an application to re-designate the boundaries of the Suffolk County Empire Zone. This local law would authorize the designation of a revised Empire Zone to include Miteq, Inc., Inc. properties in Hauppauge.

If these new boundaries are accepted by the New York State Department of Economic Development, the above properties would be granted an exemption from real property taxes, special ad valorem levies, and certain other taxes by the County of Suffolk pursuant to State law.

The Police Department has requested creation of this title to enhance serving the Spanish speaking community. A new title is needed for this position to ensure that an incumbent will have the ability to communicate via the Spanish language. The salary level will be the same as that of a Police Officer.

Please initiate this resolution to add the new title to the Classification and Salary Plan. A draft of our proposed specification is attached for your reference.

POLICE OFFICER (SPANISH SPEAKING)

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS

The work involves enforcing municipal and state laws governing a political unit to protect the lives, property and legal rights of the public. The Police Officer patrols a designated area to assist in emergencies and to apprehend or issue summonses to lawbreakers. The work is performed in accordance with departmental regulations under the supervision of a superior officer and is subject to review through submission of oral and written reports. The duties require proficiency in both the Spanish and English languages. Performs related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES

Patrols assigned area in a patrol car, on motorcycle or on foot for the preservation of law and order through the prevention of or detection of criminal acts;

Answers calls for assistance in connection with automobile accidents and other accident emergency situations;

Answers calls regarding robberies, domestic disturbances, homicides, suicides and all other situations requiring police action or intervention;

Assists and interacts with the Spanish-speaking public;

Controls traffic flow when power failure results in loss of traffic signals;

Issues summonses to violators of traffic safety laws;

Administers first aid at accident or crime scenes;

Gathers evidence, locates witnesses and arrests suspects at crime scenes;

Locates and arrests persons for whom warrants or court orders have been issued.

FULL PERFORMANCE, KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS

Good knowledge of the communities, public buildings, landmarks, roads, parks, industrial and commercial areas in the assigned work area; good knowledge of first-aid procedures; ability to learn how to care for and use firearms skillfully; ability to enforce the law with firmness, tact, and impartiality; ability to act quickly and calmly in emergencies; ability to read, write and converse fluently in both the Spanish and English languages; ability to meet physical requirements established by municipal authority; physical strength and agility determined by qualifying tests.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

OPEN COMPETITIVE

Graduation from a standard senior high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma by the date of appointment.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must be at least twenty (20) years of age at the time of appointment.

Candidates who reach their thirty-fifth (35<sup>th</sup>) birthday before the date of the written examination are not eligible, except as follows:

Candidates may have a period of active military duty, up to six (6) years as defined in Section 243 (10-a) of the Military Law, deducted from their age for purposes of determining whether they meet the age requirement.

There will be qualifying medical, psychological, physical fitness, and polygraph evaluations.

There will be a qualifying Spanish language examination.

Candidates must be United State Citizens at the time of appointment.

Possession of a valid New York State driver's license at the time of appointment; appointees must maintain a valid license throughout their employment in this title.


After appointment, candidates will be required to successfully complete a Police Officer Training Course recognized by the New York State Municipal Training Council.
