**RESOLUTION NO. 7/3 -2010, ADOPTING 2010-2011  
OPERATING BUDGET TOTAL FOR SUFFOLK COUNTY  
COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

**WHEREAS**, changes in NEW YORK EDUCATION LAW and amendments to State University of New York ("SUNY") regulations granted greater fiscal autonomy to the State's Community Colleges; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of these changes, this Legislature rescinded the Plan "C" Agreement which previously governed the County's sponsorship of Suffolk County Community College and approved new operating agreements with the College; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to controlling state law and regulations and the provisions of the new operating agreements between the County and the College, the County no longer has the authority to veto line item appropriations in the Operating Budget proposed by the College's Board of Trustees; and

**WHEREAS**, the County's budget authority is limited to approving an Operating Budget total and County Contribution for the Community College; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of Suffolk Community College submitted their 2010-2011 Operating Budget request with line item detail to the County Executive and the County Legislature on April 16, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, the budget request submitted by the Community College's Board of Trustees proposed an increase in the County Contribution of 4% and a total budget of \$189,363,918; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Executive submitted to this Legislature a Recommended Budget which included a zero increase in the County Contribution with a commensurate reduction of \$1.5 million for a total college budget of \$187,819,799 on June 1, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, the Budget Review Office issued a Review of the Recommended 2010-2011 Suffolk Community College Budget on June 16, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, the Suffolk County Legislature held public hearings on the Community College's Recommended Budget on June 16, 2010 and June 22, 2010; now, therefore be it


**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that all Whereas clauses and all Resolved clauses denominated 1<sup>st</sup> through 4th inclusive, contained in the Suffolk Community College Recommended Budget 2010-2011, are hereby stricken and not approved, and shall not appear in the printed 2010-2011 Suffolk Community College Adopted Budget; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature hereby approves an Operating Budget Total of \$187,819,799 for Suffolk Community College during fiscal year September 1, 2010 to August 31, 2011; and be it further

3<sup>rd</sup>        **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature approves a total contribution by the County of Suffolk ("local sponsor share") in the amount of \$38,602,957; which is comprised of \$34,197,742 County contribution and a Discretionary Tax Levy in the amount of \$4,405,215 as recommended by the County Executive.
