Dear Presiding Officer Lindsay and Members of the Suffolk County Legislature:

RESOLUTION NO. 420-2011 AMENDING THE PROPOSED 2012-2014 CAPITAL PROGRAM AND THE PROPOSED 2012 CAPITAL BUDGET.

I am returning Resolution 420-2011 vetoed in its entirety.

This budget amendment adds \$175,000 in the three-year program for CP 1766: Building for Wildlife Rescue and Education, Marine Science Center at Cornell Cooperative Extension. The funding will be used to complete internal infrastructure of a building that was constructed in 2006 and is currently being utilized for storage. Now is certainly not the time to add to the County's overall debt by adding offices and classrooms.

During these challenging fiscal times I must again emphasize that the County has had to scale back its projects and do more with less. It is only fair to ask organizations and contract agencies affiliated with the County, such as Cornell Cooperative Extension, to do more with less as well. While allocating county resources for planning and construction of this building is a worthy goal in heartier economic times, now is not the time for such county investment.

I urge you once again to sustain my veto.
