RESOLUTION NO. 423-2011 AMENDING THE PROPOSED 2012-2014 CAPITAL PROGRAM AND THE PROPOSED 2012 CAPITAL BUDGET.

I am returning Resolution 423-2011 vetoed in its entirety.

Increasing debt for non-essentials in these fiscally challenging times is inappropriate. Since the Legislature has voted not to transfer ownership of this bulkhead, the County has retained ownership of the Long Wharf; CP 5375 Bulkheads at Various Locations is an existing project through which to fund maintenance concerns as they arise. Adding \$400,000 to a redundant project is not appropriate.

I urge you once again to sustain my veto.
