Dear Presiding Officer Lindsay and Members of the Legislature:


I am returning herein **RESOLUTION NO. 1196 – 2011, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS ON CR 17, CARLETON AVENUE (WHEELER ROAD), TOWN OF ISLIP (CP 5097)**; vetoed in its entirety.

The executive branch made a policy determination to scale back the capital budget to deal with the difficult economic conditions we face. Major infrastructure was given priority in order to spur economic development, but other items that might have breezed through in better years, were delayed.

The legislature often says that the capital budget doesn't authorize spending, it merely creates a plan. However by placing every item in the budget up for authorization, it shatters that concept and eliminates any form of prioritization in order to control debt service levels.

For these reasons, I strongly urge the Legislature to sustain my veto of this resolution.

RESOLUTION NO. 1196-2011, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS ON CR 17, CARLETON AVENUE (WHEELER ROAD), TOWN OF ISLIP (CP 5097)

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works has requested funds for engineering in connection with Intersection Improvements on CR 17, Wheeler Road in the Town of Islip; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds within the 2012 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994 and as amended by Resolution No. 461-2006 has established a priority ranking system as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$400,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5(c) (20), (21) and (27) and of Title 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR"), in that the law authorizes information collection, including basic data collection and research, and preliminary planning processes necessary to formulate a proposal for an action, but does not commit the County to commence or approve an action. Since this law is a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of fifty-three (53) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 571-1998 and reaffirmed by Resolution No. 209-2000; and be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that the County Department of Public Works is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to take such action as may be necessary to complete Intersection Improvements on CR 17, Wheeler Road in the Town of Islip, pursuant to Section C8-2(A) of the Suffolk County Charter; and be it further

4th RESOLVED, that the proceeds of \$400,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:
