Recommendations for Legislative Resolutions Laid on the Table March 28, 2017

Mr. Corral noted that the staff's SEQRA recommendations are listed on the March 28, 2017 LADS reports.

Mr. Corral also pointed out a number projects that have recently been reviewed by the CEQ which are moving forward. In addition, Mr. Corral noted that he clarified with the project sponsor's office that IR 1216-2017, which is for Improvements to Van Bourgondien County Park, does not involve the Van Bourgondien building which is dedicated to the Suffolk County Historic Trust. Instead the project involves improvements to the Park's parking lot area,

playground and park entrances which are not in the vicinity of the historic building.
