(Pres. Off.)

T 1964 5-0-0-0 Repealing its cents per gallon rate sales and compensating use taxes on motor fuel and diesel motor fuel, thus restoring its percentage rate of such taxes, pursuant to the authority of article 29 of the tax law of the State of New York
