

Dear County Executive Bellone and Presiding Officer Gregory,

The Ronkonkoma HUB is the centerpiece for the Town of Brookhaven's Transit-Oriented Development (TOD) initiative. A redevelopment project initiated by a previous administration, its intent is to transform a struggling commercial district surrounding the Long Island Rallroad's Ronkonkoma station by creating thousands of jobs and providing affordable housing for seniors and young people.

From its inception, the Town has been supportive of the plan's effort to reverse our region's "Brain Drain" by building much needed affordable housing for our Millennial population many of whom are leaving Long Island. The mixed-use component of the plan further would provide a live-work-play setting so critical to the creation of the kind of a vibrant interpersonal environment that would begin to reverse the ill effects of widespread suburban sprawl.

Initially developed as a Town Comprehensive Land Use Plan Initiative to redevelop a blighted area surrounding the Ronkonkoma train station, the Town felt that selecting a Master Developer for the project would assure that planning theory and pragmatic reality would create a more viable financial project. To that end, the East Setauket Real Estate Development Company Tritec Development was selected for the proposed \$540 million-dollar project. Soon thereafter, Brookhaven Town and Tritec began an extensive joint planning revitalization process. For their part, Tritec was responsive, diligent and very cooperative in working with the Town to reach a site development plan that not only met Tritec's financial objectives but also the Town and local civic planning concerns for the proper redevelopment of that area.

Ronkonkoma HUB envisions an extensive mixed use community. When construction is completed, the HUB is expected to have upwards of 1,450 apartments and 545,000 square feet of retail and office space on about 50 acres. Over the projected six-year construction phase, it is anticipated that 11,700 construction jobs will be generated and that 2,740 permanent jobs will be created at its full build out completion. In addition, there will be thousands of indirect jobs created as a result of the stimulation of regional firms providing goods and services for this project.

Working closely with Brookhaven's IDA, more than \$115 million in financial incentives will be provided to assure the success of the project. This project will result in over \$330 million in sales tax, property tax (PILOTs) and income tax benefit to the state and region. The Town Board has been fully supportive of Tritec's efforts, voting unanimously for the adoption of the plan and its rezoning.

The site development strategy was progressive in its land use approach. In order to ensure the Orderly development of the varying phases, the plan was fashioned with a form-based zoning code that would allow Tritec maximum future market flexibility provided that they followed the design criteria outlined in the code. The orderly development of the varying phases would then be assured through the life of the project.

Public funding has been provided by Suffolk County for the sewage treatment plant connection as well as funding provided by New York State Regional Economic Council for other public amenities. Ronkonkoma HUB is a regional planning effort that shows how public-private partnerships can work at a collaborate level to accomplish that which otherwise could not be achieved.
