I'm going to open the public hearing on Introductory Resolution Number **1256 of 2016, Authorizing the renewal of the lease of premises located at 1850 New York Avenue, Huntington Station, NY for use by Third District Court. (Co. Exec.).**

I'll read the public notice into the record. It is dated March 22, 2016. It's to the Honorable Bridget Fleming, chairman, and members of the Ways and Means committee, and it's from AnnMarie Pastore, legislative aide. It reads:
