It is proposed that the project will be implemented during 2009 and that \$1,000,000 in serial bonds will be appropriated in 2010 with the first interest payment in 2010 and the maximum payment year being 2011. It is indicated in the map, plan and report that the project will require serial bonds and the financial impact of the project will be \$13.00 per year per typical property.

Project Description

The increase and improvement to Suffolk County Sewer District No. 23 – Coventry Manor of the process improvement project includes construction of new process tanks and installation of equipment and systems. The project is more fully described and defined in the aforementioned maps, plans, report and recommendations. The estimate of the cost associated with the increase and improvement project is \$1.0 million.

A copy of the map, plan, and estimate of costs relating to said proposed increase and improvement of facilities is on file in the Office of the Clerk of said County Legislature where the same may be examined during regular business hours.
