**Request for Bid for Supply of Natural Gas**

The work consists of the following: Suffolk County will contract with an Energy Services Company (ESCO) for the purchase of natural gas for various accounts listed in the Request for Bid (RFB) in Suffolk County. This RFB seeks the delivery of primary firm point-to-point transportation to the National Grid (KeySpan LI) City Gate.

Awards will be made to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder in conjunction with Section A4-14 of the Suffolk County Administration Code establishing an optional ten percent (10%) local (Nassau/Suffolk) preference program for Suffolk County contracts.
