BOND RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, NEW YORK, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$630,850 BONDS TO FINANCE THE COST OF THE PLANNING AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE OCKERS SURFACE WATER TRANSPORTATION CENTER AT LONG ISLAND MARITIME MUSEUM GROUNDS AT CHARLES DOMINY COUNTY PARK, WEST SAYVILLE (CP 7165.112 and .312)

The object or purpose for which the bonds are authorized is the planning and construction of the Ockers Surface Water Transportation Center at Long Island Maritime Museum grounds at Charles Dominy County Park, West Sayville, at the estimated maximum cost of \$630,850.

The amount of obligations to be issued is \$630,850. It is expected that Federal Aid funds in the amount of \$504,680 (80%) and other funds from the Long Island Maritime Museum in the amount of \$63,085 (10%) will be received in connection with this project. The County must initially fund the entire cost of the project and expects to be reimbursed, in part, by the Federal and other aid. The County Comptroller will be limited to the issuance of bond anticipation notes for the Federal/other shares of \$567,765.
