CONTRACT NO. 1 - GENERAL CONSTRUCTION

The work consists of the following: Restoration and Reconstruction of Historic Mill including foundation repairs, structural timber frame repairs and replacement, new cedar siding, woodwork repairs and other miscellaneous work. The Blydenburgh Mill is a recognized historic site, listed in the National Register of Historic Places; all work shall be consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties. Qualified Bidders shall have not less than ten years successful experience in traditional American joinery and a minimum of 5 historic restoration projects of a similar type which were reviewed by a historic authority, and shall submit with their bid, a list of current and previously completed historic preservation projects, including the name of the project owner, contact person, and telephone number. The project will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder who meets the experience specified.

Contract Documents, including Instructions to Bidders, Bid Forms, Specimen Agreement, General Conditions, Specifications, Drawings and other contract documents may be examined and obtained at the Offices of Suffolk County Department of Public Works, Purchasing Unit, Room 132, 335 Yaphank Avenue, Yaphank, New York 11980, between the hours of 9:30AM and 3:30PM daily, except Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, on or after November 12, 2009.

A mandatory site visit will be held on Monday November 30, 2009 at 10:00am. Any bidders unable to attend the mandatory site visit shall contact the project manager prior to November 25, 2009 to make alternate arrangements to visit the site.

A deposit of One Hundred dollars (\$100.00) in the form of a check will be required for one full set of Contract Documents. Deposit checks or money orders shall be made payable to the "Suffolk County Treasurer." Cash will not be accepted.

Prospective BIDDERS or their agents will be required to provide the following information in order to obtain a set of Drawings, Project Manual and Proposal Forms: Company Name,

Address, Telephone and FAX Number, E-Mail Address, and Federal ID Number.

A full refund will be made to bidders for return of one set of Contract Documents. A 50% refund will be made for return of any additional sets. A 50% refund will be made to Non-Bidders for each set returned. The successful bidder will receive full refund for all sets. Contract Documents must be in good condition and must be returned within thirty (30) days of award or rejection of bids. Deposit on sets not returned within this period will be forfeited.

Bids for this contract shall be submitted in a separate sealed envelope with name of the contract clearly noted on the outside of the envelope. Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total Base Bid, made payable to the Suffolk County Treasurer. The bid bond will be held as a guarantee that in the event the bid is accepted and contract awarded to the Bidder, the contract will be duly executed and properly secured.
