BOND RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, NEW YORK, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$3,558,000 BONDS TO FINANCE THE COST OF THE PLANNING AND CONSTRUCTION IN CONNECTION WITH ALTERNATIVE FUEL INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS (ARRA) (CP 5602.110 and .311)

The object or purpose for which the bonds are authorized is the planning and construction for alternative fuel infrastructure improvements (ARRA), at the estimated maximum cost of \$3,558,000.

The amount of obligations to be issued is \$3,558,000. It is expected that Federal Aid funds in the amount of \$1,779,000 (50%) will be received in connection with this project. The County must initially fund the entire cost of the project and expects to be reimbursed, in part, by the Federal aid. The County Comptroller will be limited to the issuance of bond anticipation notes for the Federal share of \$1,779,000.

The period of probable usefulness of the bonds is fifteen (15) years.

BOND RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, NEW YORK, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$700,000 BONDS TO FINANCE THE COST OF THE ACQUISITION OF COMPRESSED NATURAL GAS VEHICLES (ARRA) (CP 5602.512)

The object or purpose for which the bonds are authorized is the acquisition of compressed natural gas vehicles (ARRA), at the estimated maximum cost of \$700,000.

The amount of obligations to be issued is \$700,000. It is expected that Federal Aid funds in the amount of \$350,000 (50%) will be received in connection with this project. The County must initially fund the entire cost of the project and expects to be reimbursed, in part, by the Federal aid. The County Comptroller will be limited to the issuance of bond anticipation notes for the Federal share of \$350,000.

The period of probable usefulness of the bonds is five (5) years.
