The TPA will act as an agent for the County to:

- Administer major medical and/or hospital claims for the self-funded plan for County employees and retirees
- Provide overall administrative services of all programs required by the RFP, including but not limited to:
 - Utilization review and quality assurance; and
 - Administration of healthcare provider networks; and
 - Providing eligibility data to other TPAs; and
 - Printing and distribution of claim forms, plan description booklets, provider directories and educational information; and
 - Maintaining participating provider agreements.
 - Mental Health and substance abuse providers are not included in this RFP.
 - Proposers may submit proposals to act as TPA for either major medical benefits only, or hospital benefits only, or both major medical and hospital benefits.
