The project will include remedial activities to excavate and dispose of petroleum impacted soils which exceed New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) restricted residential soil cleanup objectives (RRSCOs) as specified in 6NYCRR Part 375.

The vertical extent of impact exceeding the Part 375 Restricted Residential RRSCOs encompasses a 6,000 square foot area as shown on the project technical drawings. Vertically, impacted soils are located at a depth of approximately 30' – 35' below grade. After the removal is completed the area is to be backfilled and restored.
