BOND RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, NEW YORK, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$30,000,000 BONDS TO FINANCE A PART OF THE COST OF ACQUISITION OF LAND AND/OR DEVELOPMENT RIGHTS UNDER THE SUFFOLK COUNTY 1/4% DRINKING WATER PROTECTION PROGRAM FOR ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION LAND ACQUISITIONS (CP 8712.210)

The object or purpose for which the bonds are authorized is the acquisition of land and/or development rights under the Suffolk County 1/4% Drinking Water Protection Program for environmental protection land acquisitions, at the estimated maximum cost of \$163,000,000.
