Notice is hereby given that the Suffolk County Department of Public Works is seeking proposals from qualified firms to provide and install an automatic vehicle locator system for the Suffolk County Transit (SCT) and Suffolk County Accessible Transportation (SCAT) bus systems.

The deadline for technical questions is October 15, 2010 by 3:30 p.m. and must be in writing (fax/email acceptable). Proposals received after the deadline for receipt of proposals will be considered late and will be returned unopened to the proposer. There will be a NON-Mandatory Proposers' Conference held at the Suffolk County Purchasing Office in Yaphank, NY on November 5, 2010.

All proposers will be required to comply with all applicable Equal Opportunity laws and regulations. The County of Suffolk hereby notifies all proposers that, in regard to any contract entered into as a result of this request, disadvantaged enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit proposals and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, religion, color, sex, disability, age, Vietnam era veteran status, marital status, or national origin in consideration for an award.

Each contract is subject to financial assistance contracts between the County of Suffolk, New York, the New York State Department of Transportation, and the U.S. Department of Transportation. Federal Transit Administration (FTA) capital grant funds (FTA Project Nos. NY-90-X602, NY-90-X617, and NY-90-X648) will be used to finance up to 80 percent of the total cost.

The County of Suffolk reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, in whole or in part, to enter into multiple contracts, and to make an award(s) as deemed in the best interest of the County. Further, the County reserves the right to waive any formalities or informalities contained in the RFP.

Proposals may not be withdrawn for sixty (60) days after the RFP due date noted above.
