The object or purpose for which the bonds are authorized is the payment of a judgment in a bus liability case, at the estimated maximum cost of \$350,000.

The amount of obligations to be issued is \$350,000.

BOND RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, NEW YORK, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$954,766 BONDS TO FINANCE THE COST OF ENERGY CONSERVATION IMPROVEMENTS AT VARIOUS COUNTY FACILITIES (CP 1664.317)

The object or purpose for which the bonds are authorized is the energy conservation improvements at various County facilities, at the estimated maximum cost of \$954,766.

The amount of obligations to be issued is \$954,766. It is expected that Federal funds under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) shall be available in the amount of \$954,766 (100%) through a grant to be administered by the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA). The County must initially fund the entire cost of the project and expects to be reimbursed, in full, from the Federal aid. The County Comptroller shall be limited to the issuance of bond anticipation notes to finance the Federal share (100%) of the project.

The period of probable usefulness of the bonds is fifteen (15) years.

BOND RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, NEW YORK, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$600,000 BONDS TO FINANCE THE COST OF THE ACQUISITION OF PROPERTIES FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF CR 3, PINELAWN ROAD, TOWNS OF HUNTINGTON AND BABYLON (CP 5510.211)

The object or purpose for which the bonds are authorized is the acquisition of properties for the reconstruction of CR 3, Pinelawn Road, Town of Huntington and Babylon, at the estimated maximum cost of \$7,130,250.

The amount of obligations authorized to be issued is \$600,000, in addition to the \$6,530,250 heretofore authorized. Federal aid in the amount of \$480,000 is expected to be received and the County Comptroller shall therefore be limited to the issuance of bond anticipation notes for the Federal share of \$480,000.

The period of probable usefulness of the bonds is fifteen (15) years, computed from May 15, 2006.
