BOND RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, NEW YORK, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$250,000 BONDS TO FINANCE THE COST OF CONSTRUCTION OF A SKATE PARK IN SAYVILLE (CP 7113.110 and .310)

The object or purpose for which the bonds are authorized is the construction of a skate park in Sayville, at the estimated maximum cost of \$250,000.

The amount of obligations to be issued is \$250,000.

The period of probable usefulness of the bonds is fifteen (15) years.
