The work consists of the following:

1. Slip lining of approximately 500 linear feet of existing 48” diameter reinforced concrete sanitary sewer interceptor piping (i.e., host pipe), including all equipment, tools, labor and materials for cleaning of the host pipe; removal of obstructions; providing for all necessary repairs/grouting of the host pipe and; slip lining of the host pipe with the specified slipliner pipe. Contractor shall grub, clear land, remove vegetation, excavate and prepare the required jacking/slip lining pit to accommodate the slip lining activities. The number of excavations shall be minimized by inserting the slip lining pipe in both directions from a single opening. Contractor shall provide for well point dewatering and sheeting and shoring, as required, so that the excavation for the jacking/slip lining pit is performed completely in the dry. Contractor shall first clean sections of the sewer piping and manholes designated for rehabilitation utilizing high-pressure water and vacuum assisted cleaning vehicles and provide for proper offsite transportation and disposal of the materials. Disposal costs shall be included in the bid and an original signature copy of all disposal tickets, weigh station receipts, and other documents related to the appropriate disposal of the waste materials shall accompany any payment request that includes disposal costs.
