Awards will be made to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder in conjunction with Section A4-14 of the Suffolk County Administrative Code establishing an optional ten percent (10%) local (Nassau/Suffolk) preference program for Suffolk County contracts.

The work consists of the following: Replacement of existing Flight Line (runway apron) lighting in the vicinity of the Terminal Building at Francis S. Gabreski Airport. Work to consist of construction of five new metallic poles, plus concrete foundations, each equipped with two 1000 watt luminaires. Also install backbone for new electrical service, with provision for future LIPA metering. Also relocation of existing power for existing lights and access gate to new electrical service and provision of new panelboard. Also new walkway lighting. After construction is complete demolish the old lighting (six poles).
