NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Suffolk County Legislature has passed Introductory Resolution No. 1195 -2012 and presented to me for approval Local Law No. -2012, "A Charter Law to Prevent a Court Imposed Redistricting Plan" which law requires that in the event the Reapportionment Commission fails to submit a plan by the February 1st deadline the Suffolk County Legislature must adopt a redistricting plan of legislative boundaries by June 1, 2012 or within 120 days after the State of New York adopts a plan to reapportion State Senate and Assembly districts, whichever date is later. Only if the Suffolk County Legislature fails to adopt a plan within the given timeframe would the County Attorney be required to apply to a court of appropriate jurisdiction for the appointment of a Special Master to prepare a redistricting plan for revisions to the boundaries of the legislative districts in Suffolk County so that they will contain substantially equal citizen population.
