Sealed bids will be received at the Office of Suffolk County Department of Public Works, Purchasing Unit, (Room 103), 335 Yaphank Avenue, Yaphank, New York 11980, until 11:00 AM local time on May 10, 2012 at which time they will be publicly opened and read for:

**SUFFOLK COUNTY SEWER DISTRICT NO. 3 –
BERGEN POINT WWTP – BOILER BREECHING/STACK
CAPITAL PROJECT NO. CP 8170**

- A. The purpose of the project is to replace the existing breeching flue stack system servicing the six AERCO boilers (five existing and one future) at the Bergen Point Wastewater Treatment Plant owned by Suffolk County.
- B. This abbreviated summary is provided in order to acquaint the bidder with the work covered by the Contract Documents for Contract Capital Project 8170. It is not all inclusive of the work under the Contract. The Work includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - 1. Demolish, remove and disposal of the existing breeching flue and stack system.
 - 2. Furnish and install the new breeching flue and stack system servicing the five existing boilers. For the future boiler, furnish the 8 inch breeching flue, but installation is not included as part of this contract.
 - 3. Furnish and install the breeching flue and stack drainage system.
 - 4. Startup participation for the various equipment and systems of the project and provide complete service to troubleshoot and assist manufacturer service representatives in obtaining a completely functional installation.
 - 5. Project closeout submittals.
 - 6. All other work shown and specified within the Contract Documents.

CONTRACT NO. 1 – H.V.A.C.

Note: This Project is to be bid as a **single prime project**. Bidders shall submit with their bids, a separate sealed list that names each subcontractor that the bidder will use to perform work on the contract, and the agreed-upon amount to be paid to each as applicable, for: (a) plumbing and gas fitting (i.e., Plumbing Work), (b) steam heating, hot water heating, ventilating and air conditioning apparatus (i.e., HVAC Work which includes fire sprinkler) and (c) electric wiring and standard illuminating fixtures (i.e., Electrical Work). The apparent low bidder's subcontract information will be opened and read aloud at the bid opening.

Contract Documents, including Instructions to Bidders, Bid Forms, Specimen Agreement, General Conditions, Specifications, Drawings and other contract documents may be examined and obtained at the Offices of Suffolk County Department of Public Works, Purchasing Unit, Room 132, 335 Yaphank Avenue, Yaphank, New York 11980, between the hours of 9:30AM and 3:30PM daily, except Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, on or after April 13, 2012.

A deposit of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) in the form of a check will be required for one full set of Contract Documents. Deposit checks or money orders shall be made payable to the "Suffolk County Treasurer." Cash will not be accepted.

A Pre-Bid Meeting and site walk through is scheduled for April 26, 2012 at 9:00 AM at the Suffolk County Sewer District No. 3 Bergen Point Wastewater Treatment Plant Administration Building Main Lobby, 600 Bergen Avenue, West Babylon, New York 11704.

Prospective BIDDERS or their agents will be required to provide the following information in order to obtain a set of Drawings, Project Manual and Proposal Forms: Company Name, Address, Telephone and FAX Number, E-Mail Address, and Federal ID Number.

A full refund will be made to bidders for return of one set of Contract Documents. A 50% refund will be made for return of any additional sets. A 50% refund will be made to Non-Bidders for each set returned. The successful bidder will receive full refund for all sets. Contract Documents must be in good condition and must be returned within thirty (30) days of award or rejection of bids. Deposit on sets not returned within this period will be forfeited.

Bids for this contract shall be submitted in a separate sealed envelope with name of the contract clearly noted on the outside of the envelope. Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total Base Bid, made payable to the Suffolk County Treasurer. The bid bond will be held as a guarantee that in the event the bid is accepted and contract awarded to the Bidder, the contract will be duly executed and properly secured.

Awards will be made to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder in conjunction with Section A4-14 of the Suffolk County Administration Code establishing an optional ten percent (10%) local (Nassau/Suffolk) preference program for Suffolk County contracts.

The bids shall be delivered in person by the Bidder or his agent at the time and place stated.
