NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that I.R. 2161, CALLING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE CONSENT TO THE ACQUISITION OF ADDITIONAL LAND AT SEA BREEZE AVENUE, TOWN OF SOUTHAMPTON, COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, STATE OF NEW YORK, BY THE WESTHAMPTON CEMETERY ASSOCIATION FOR CEMETERY EXPANSION PURPOSES.

The work consists of the following:

Removal and Replacement of Damaged and Undermined Concrete Walkways. Replacement of Four (4) Beach Access Staircases from the Park Pavilion and Camping Facilities. Staircase Replacement to include the Removal and Replacement of Timber Piles and Replacement of Staircases, Handicapped Ramp, Outlook and Boardwalks.

Eligible bidders must have obtained bid documents from the Suffolk County Department of Public Works Purchasing Unit.**

A deposit of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) in the form of a check will be required for one full set of Contract Documents. Deposit checks or money orders shall be made payable to the "Suffolk County Treasurer". Cash will not be accepted.

Prospective BIDDERS or their agents will be required to provide the following information in order to obtain a set of Drawings, Project Manual and proposal forms: Company Name, Address, Telephone, Email Address, Facsimile Number and Federal ID Number.

A full refund will be made to bidders for return of one set of Contract Documents. A 50% refund will be made for return of any additional sets. A 50% refund will be made to Non-Bidders for each set returned. The successful bidder will receive full refund for all sets. Contract Documents must be in good condition and must be returned within thirty (30) days of award or rejection of bids. Deposit on sets not returned within this period will be forfeited.

Bids for this contract shall be submitted in a separate sealed envelope with the name of the contract clearly noted on the outside of the envelope. Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total Base Bid, made payable to the Suffolk County Treasurer. This bid bond will be held as a guarantee that in the event the bid is accepted and contract awarded to the Bidder, the contract will be duly executed and properly secured.

Awards will be made to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder in conjunction with Section A4-14 of the Suffolk County Administrative Code establishing an optional ten percent (10%) local (Nassau/Suffolk) preference program for Suffolk County contracts.

The bids shall be delivered in person, by the Bidder or his agent, at the time and place stated.

Please note that all construction projects over \$250,000 advertised after July 17, 2008 will be subject to training requirements pursuant to Section 220-h of the NYS Labor Law.

Please note that all construction contracts involving construction, reconstruction, improvement, rehabilitation, installation, alteration, renovation, demolition, or otherwise providing for any building, facility or physical structure of any kind with a value in excess of \$250,000 and up to \$3,000,000 after March 27, 2002 will be subject to Apprenticeship Training Program requirements pursuant to Article 23, Section 816b of the NYS Labor Law and Suffolk County Resolution No. 190-2002.

## NOTICE OF HEARING

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Transportation Division of the Suffolk County Department of Public Works has been directed in the Suffolk County 2013 Operating Budget to hold public hearings to consider implementing increased fares on Suffolk County Accessible Transportation (SCAT) buses.

Pending the outcome of this public hearing, the proposed bus fares would be scheduled to take effect on Wednesday, May 1, 2013. The fare as proposed would be:

**One-way, SCAT: \$4.00**

**THE FIRST HEARING** will be held on **Wednesday, March 6, 2013**, from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. in the Suffolk County Legislative Auditorium, W.H. Rogers Legislature Building, 725 Veterans Memorial Highway, Smithtown, New York.

**THE SECOND HEARING** will be held on **Thursday, March 7, 2013**, from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. in the Suffolk County Legislative Auditorium in the Evans K. Griffing Building, 300 Center Drive, Riverhead, New York.

**AT THESE HEARINGS**, an opportunity will be afforded for all interested persons or agencies to be heard with respect to the effect on energy conservation and the social, economic and environmental impact of the proposed fare changes and to submit evidence and recommendations, orally or in writing, with respect to the proposed fare changes. Those wishing to be heard may in advance, either by mail or in person, at the hearing. It is advisable to pre-register by mail prior to the hearing inasmuch as such registrants will be heard first. Mail registrations should be sent to Garry Lenberger, Acting Director of Transportation Operations, Suffolk County DPW, Division of Transportation, 335 Yaphank Avenue, Yaphank, New York 11980-9744.

It is required that persons making oral presentations limit their comments to five minutes. Written testimony may be submitted Garry Lenberger both before and up to five (5) days following the hearing.

Interpreter services will be made available to deaf persons, at no charge, upon written request submitted no later than 10 days prior to the scheduled public hearing. The written request must be sent to Garry Lenberger at the above-noted address.

The public hearing has been scheduled at a place that is accessible to persons with a mobility impairment. Wheelchair-lift-equipped Suffolk County Transit bus service is available to the Suffolk County North Complex via Routes S27, S33, S45, S54 and S62 and to the Riverhead County Center via Routes S58, S62, S66, S90, S92 and 8A. For transit bus information, phone 631-852-5200 between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., weekdays.
