NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Suffolk County Legislature has passed Introductory Resolution No.1698-13 “A Local Law to Strengthen Suffolk County’s E-911 Service” which law makes changes to the E-911 program affecting the distribution of surcharge revenues including requiring service suppliers to remit surcharge revenues to the Suffolk County Police Department. It also requires that at least 20% of moneys remitted be allocated to the Public Safety Answering Points (PSAP) not operated by the County (non-County PSAPs) and authorizes the majority of the representatives of the non-County PSAPs to determine distribution of the amounts received. It further requires that the sums so allocated be distributed within sixty (60) days of the end of each quarter.
