The work consists of the following:

The work generally consists of the upgrade and replacement of the effluent pumping system including pumps, controls, cone valves and piping as well as electrical control and distribution equipment and replacement of the pump station HVAC system.

**CONTRACT NO.1 - GENERAL CONSTRUCTION**

Note: This Project is to be bid as a single prime project since it incorporates a Project Labor Agreement. Bidders shall submit with their bids, a separate sealed list that names each subcontractor that the bidder will use to perform work on the contract, and the agreed-upon amount to be paid to each as applicable, for: (a) plumbing and gas fitting (i.e., Plumbing Work), (b) steam heating, hot water heating, ventilating and air conditioning apparatus (i.e., HVAC Work which includes fire sprinkler) and (c) electric wiring and standard illuminating fixtures (i.e., Electrical Work). The apparent low bidder's subcontract information will be opened and read aloud at the bid opening.

A Pre-Bid conference and walkthrough inspection of the site will be held on Thursday, June 19, 2014 at 9:00 am at the Bergen Point WWTP Administration Building conference room.

A second site visit will be held on Thursday, June 26 from 9:00 am to 12: noon, for prospective bidders to informally walk the site. Visitors will be escorted out to Final Effluent Pump Station (FEPS) area at 9:00AM, 10:00AM and 11:00AM; so please plan to arrive at those times to join the site tour. The second site visit is not mandatory and questions will not be fielded by County staff. Visitors must sign in at the plant Administrative Building after parking. Interference or hindering the activities of County personnel or the operation of the wastewater treatment plant is prohibited on both occasions.

Bids for this contract shall be submitted in a separate sealed envelope with the name of the contract clearly noted on the outside of the envelope. Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total Base Bid, made payable to the Suffolk County Treasurer. This bid bond will be held as a guarantee that in the event the bid is accepted and contract awarded to the Bidder, the contract will be duly executed and properly secured. **E-MAILED BIDS WILL BE CONSIDERED UNRESPONSIVE.**

Awards will be made to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder in conjunction with Section A4-14 of the Suffolk County Administrative Code establishing an optional ten percent (10%) local (Nassau/Suffolk) preference program for Suffolk County contracts.

The bids shall be delivered in person, by the Bidder or his agent, at the time and place stated.
