NOTICE OF ADOPTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the County Legislature of the County of Suffolk, New York, adopted Resolution No. 473-2014 on June 3, 2014, and the County Executive approved same on June 6, 2014. The text of this duly certified resolution is as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 473 -2014, LEGALIZING AND VALIDATING CERTAIN ACTS OF THE SMITHTOWN FIRE DISTRICT IN CONNECTION WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SUBSTATION ON PLYMOUTH BOULEVARD, SMITHTOWN, AND THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR SAID PURPOSE FROM A CAPITAL RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, Section 227 of NEW YORK COUNTY LAW authorizes the Suffolk County Legislature to legalize and validate any act of a local municipality within the County, taken in connection with a lawful municipal purpose or object; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with County Law § 227, the Smithtown Fire District submitted a petition to the Clerk of the County Legislature on April 28, 2014, seeking such relief in connection with acts taken by the District in connection with a new substation on Plymouth Boulevard, Smithtown; the petition is attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, according to the petition, sworn to by Thomas A. Buffa, the Chairman of the Fire District's Board of Commissioners, the Board of Fire Commissioners determined it would be in the best interest of the residents of the District to demolish an existing substation on Plymouth Boulevard and construct a new substation on the site; and

WHEREAS, the District's petition further states that the Board passed a resolution on June 19, 2012, authorizing the expenditure of \$2,801,430 from a Capital Reserve Fund for the subject project; and

WHEREAS, a recent audit by the New York State Comptroller's office revealed that the District failed to make the June 19, 2012 resolution subject to a permissive referendum, as required by NEW YORK GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW, and further failed to publish the required notice of the permissive referendum; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to County Law § 227, this Legislature conducted a public hearing to consider the Board's application for relief on May 13, 2014; and

WHEREAS, this Legislature has determined that the funds utilized for the Plymouth Boulevard project could only be used for buildings and grounds; that the District's failure to perform certain acts within the time prescribed by law was inadvertent and the District's failure to comply with these requirements was not the result of fraud, and no substantial hardship will result therefrom and the determination by this Legislature legalizing and validating same; and that the Fire District complied with all public bidding requirements in furthering the Plymouth Boulevard project; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that this Legislature, pursuant to County law § 227, hereby legalizes and validates the acts of the Smithtown Fire District in connection with the construction of a new substation on Plymouth Boulevard, Smithtown and the expenditure of \$2,801,430.00

out of the Capital Reserve Fund for buildings and grounds, a previously established "type" fund pursuant to § 6-g of NEW YORK GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that within twenty days of the adoption of this resolution, the Clerk of the Legislature, at the expense of the Smithtown Fire District, shall publish a certified copy of this resolution at least once a week for two consecutive weeks in the designated Smithtown newspapers, and after the completion of such publications, the Clerk of the Legislature shall file a certified copy of this resolution with the Suffolk County Clerk, the New York State Comptroller and the Clerk of the Smithtown Fire District; and be it further

3rd **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
