**CONTRACT NO.1 - GENERAL CONSTRUCTION**

Note: This Project is to be bid as a **single prime project**. Bidders shall submit with their bids, a

separate sealed list that names each subcontractor that the bidder will use to perform work on the contract, and the agreed-upon amount to be paid to each as applicable, for: (a) plumbing and gas fitting (i.e., Plumbing Work), (b) steam heating, hot water heating, ventilating and air conditioning apparatus (i.e., HVAC Work which includes fire sprinkler) and (c) electric wiring and standard illuminating fixtures (i.e., Electrical Work). The apparent low bidder's subcontract information will be opened and read aloud at the bid opening.

**Mandatory walk through:** A Mandatory Walkthrough is scheduled for **OCTOBER 16 2014 at 10 am at the Yaphank Correctional Facilities - STAFF SERVICES BUILDING (use the Suffolk Avenue entrance off Yaphank Avenue to access the facility)**.
